

Elementary Dress Code Kindergarten through Fifth Grade

Both:

ACCEPTABLE:

- Knee length shorts, capri's, jeans in any color, (including plaid), must be worn with a collared shirt or turtleneck.
- Official RCS T-shirts may be worn on Friday.
- Subtle, natural colored highlights in hair.

UNACCEPTABLE:

- No holes, tears, frayed hems or appliqués on any clothing.
- No oversized, baggy, or “high” water pants (too short having out grown).
- No logos that are offensive (determined by administration) may be worn.
- No hunting or military camouflage patterns on clothing.
- No “over shirts” such as sports jerseys are allowed.
- No flip-flops, all shoes must have a back strap.
- No hats worn in classroom or any building. May be worn outside for warmth or protection from the sun.
- No sports/athletic shorts.
- No skull symbols on shoes, clothing, backpacks or lunch boxes.
- No tanktops.
- No leggings worn as pants

Boys:

- No necklaces or earrings. Watches may be worn.
- Hair should be neatly trimmed to mid-ear, above the collar in the back and not touching the eyebrows in the front.

Girls:

- Dresses and skirts may be worn with appropriate non-collared tops.
- Dresses and skirts should be to the knee or just above.
- No spaghetti straps (unless shirt is worn underneath).
- Tops should reach the waist when arms are raised straight up (no tummies showing).
- Tight or form fitting tops or pants are not allowed.
- Girls should wear shorts under their dresses if they are going to be playing on the play equipment.
- No make-up.
- Earrings limited to one set of post style or small hoops.
- No platform or high heeled shoes. On P.E. days girls must have tennis shoes.
- Tights and/or “tight like” leggings may be worn under dresses or skirts.
